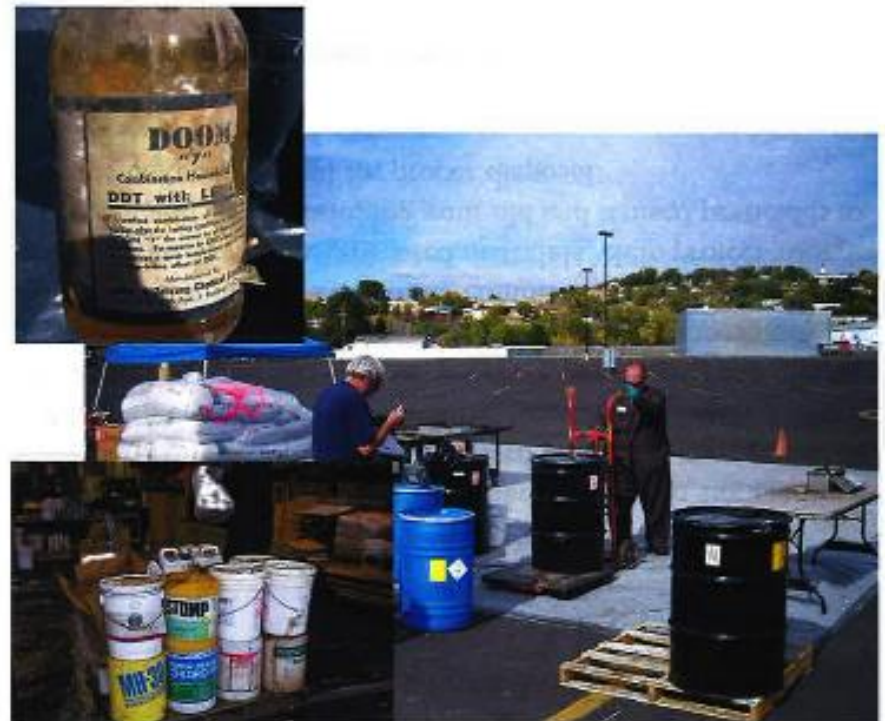

Need to dispose of old pesticides?

- ❖ **COST: FREE**
- ❖ Safely dispose of outdated or unusable pesticides on **February 5th, 2020**
- ❖ **Agricultural, commercial, forestry, and institutional waste pesticides** in Jefferson, Crook, or Deschutes Counties will be accepted. Chemicals not included in pesticide products (e.g., fertilizers, motor oils, anti-freeze, household chemicals) will **NOT** be accepted.
- ❖ Containers larger than 55 gallons will **NOT** be accepted.
- ❖ Empty plastic pesticide containers will **NOT** be accepted at this event.
- ❖ You must register with Clean Harbors Environmental so they can prepare to receive and manage the chemicals. The registration form can be obtained on-line at:
